Conditions for obtaining credit for studies abroad

- A student going abroad on an exchange to a partner university is obligated to obtain credit during the exchange for an equal number of courses during the stay abroad (the subject for subject rule).
- After being qualified for the scholarship, the student must contact the exchange co-ordinator and the head of the studies to set the curriculum during the stay in the partner university (learning agreement)
