

Master in Area Studies (MAS)

This interdisciplinary programme offers the students with its three specialized tracks 1) *Globalizing US Studies*, 2) *Integration Studies* and 3) *Transition Studies* expert knowledge and analytical-synthetic skills focused on modern history and current developments of today's world. MAS provides the students with tools for social science analysis and allows them to build their own thematic and territorial profile according to their individual needs and future career plans.

After Studies

After completion of MAS, the graduates will be endowed with internationally recognizable multi-disciplinary training in the study of international affairs. They will be able to analyze individual topics arising within the region of their interest from a multidisciplinary point of view in terms of social and modern history.

The graduates will have the opportunity to continue their self-education and become highly-skilled employees in the civil service and diplomacy, NGOs and international institutions as well as in private companies and mass-media. They will be well prepared for a variety of academic pursuits and will possess a wide range of knowledge and skills required in various social science fields.

Admissions

BECES is open to students holding a Bachelor degree in the relevant subject area who fulfil selected criteria. The admissions committee will assess the applications on the basis of submitted documents and award points (1-100) in the following categories: **academic background, motivation, extra-curricular activities**. The point limit for accepting applicants is set by the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences of Charles University.

DEADLINE for applications is 30th April 2019.

Tuition fees

Annual tuition fees for students commencing in the academic year 2019/2020 are set at 3 000 EUR for EU/EEA students and at 6 000 for non-EU/non-EEA student.
