Invites to participate in an international scientific conference

«May Studios 2019: History, Political science, International relations»

**which will take place on April 24, 2019
at Department of History of Vasyl' Stus Donetsk National University
to the address: 2 Hrushevsky Street, Vinnytsia**

Within the framework of the conference it is planned to discuss a number of aspects related to modern problems of historical science, theory and practice of state formation and public administration, as well as the development of international relations. Students, graduate students and young scientists are invited to participate.

The work of the Conference is planned in the following directions:

- 100 years of Versailles: between the past and the future.
- Apology of history: from the 20th century to the present.
- The great personality: ideology, political practices, historical narratives.
- Images of the past: historical memory and collective identity.
- Political parties in the modern world: between state and society.
- The role of civil society in the theory and practice of state-building.
- Ukraine in the context of European and world history.

The topics of the sections are not limited to the indicated directions and can be expanded in accordance with the theme of the conference, taking into account the specifics of the materials received.

To participate in the conference it is necessary to send an application by April 12, 2019 (for link: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSen8Vti3NBOVwB_ReWia0VtHivFIUqrgEMCGd_vOB1ajC1GXRg/viewform?vc=0&c=0&w=1), the abstract of the paper and a scanned (photographed) copy of the receipt for payment of the organizational fee (with the name of the participant's name) to the electronic address of the organizing committee: **studnaukadonnu@gmail.com**. According to the results of the conference the publication of its materials is foreseen.

Requirements for the abstracts:

- maximum volume is 3 A4 pages;
- the text should be typed using Word for Windows, spacing: top edges – 2 cm; bottom edges – 2 cm; left margin – 2 cm; right margin – 2 cm;
- font – Times New Roman, font size – 14, indentation – 0,75, line spacing – 1;

- reference in the text is given in the following way: [reference number, page]. For example [16, 27];
- reference should include only scientific works (articles, monographs, thesis researches);
- references are given in alphabetical order.

The abstracts should be based on the results of their own research and should not contain logical, stylistic, typographical mistakes. The organizers will be glad to review your original, not published works on the subject of the Conference.

The organizing committee of a Conference reserves the right to decide on the inclusion of each article in the proceedings by results of reviewing. At the end of the term of receiving applications for taking part in the conference and reviewing them, the official invitation will be sent to participants on e-mail, mentioned in application.

Official languages of the Conference are Ukrainian, Russian, English, Polish.

Travel and accommodation expenses are deducted from participants. Organizing Committee will assist in booking the hotel while staying in Vinnitsa.
